

# **CORTEZ GUN SHOW VENDOR APPLICATION**

**April 21, 22 & 23, 2023**

## **CORTEZ GUN SHOW RULES & CONDITIONS**

1) No pets, service animals or unsupervised children are allowed inside the Montezuma County Fairgrounds during the Gun Show hours of operations.

2) All vendors must agree to comply with the Colorado State Statute pertaining to Gun Sales.

### **COLORADO REVISED STATUTE 12-26.1-101**

**No one may transfer a firearm without first obtaining a background check through a licensed gun dealer if ANY PART OF THE TRANSACTION OCCURS ON THESE PREMISES OR PARKING FACILITIES.**

3) Once the Gun Show has opened to the public, no guns shall be allowed to leave the building unless sold and gone through the proper background check procedures provided by the Gun Show Management.

4) All vendors must agree to comply with the rules and regulations set forth by the Insurance Company that supplies the insurance for the Cortez Gun Show's 3 day event.

5) All firearms, including concealed carry guns, brought inside the gun show must be unloaded, magazines removed and actions zip tied to render them inoperable.

6) Vendors may supply their own zip ties or can ask for extras from the Cortez Gun Show's Information Table.

7) Zip ties will be regularly checked by Gun Show Volunteers throughout the three day event. Ties removed for firearm inspections will be replaced by the vendor immediately following the inspections.

8) Vendors will keep all ammunition sealed in boxes or bags and will not allow any loose ammunition on tables.

9) Vendors are prohibited from displaying or storing black powder. No

**unsealed black powder, live artillery shells, mines, grenades or similar destructive devices are allowed.**

**10) Vendors are prohibited from performing gunsmith or reloading work during the show.**

**11) The sale, display or possession of any non – NFAA registered part or combination of parts designed and intended for use in the conversion of any weapon to a machine gun is prohibited.**

**12) Vendors will not possess, consume or dispense any alcoholic beverages at any time during the Cortez Gun Show.**

**13) Displays or items for sale that glamorize racism, hatred or criminal activity are not allowed.**

**14) All Vendors understand and acknowledge the following:**

**a) Table rental fees will be paid at the time applications are submitted.**

**b) Tables may not be resold, sublet or transferred without the Gun Show Manager's approval.**

**c) If a weapon discharges at a vendor's table, the vendor will be immediately evicted from the show without refund or recourse and may face criminal or civil liability.**

**d) Vendors are responsible for the actions of their employees, agents and others in their party.**

**e) Four Corners Rifle & Pistol Club, its sponsors, officers, agents, employees and volunteers are not responsible for vendor property.**

**15) All Vendors agree to indemnify and hold the Four Corners Rifle & Pistol Club, its sponsors, officers, agents, employees and volunteers harmless from and against all liabilities, damages, losses, legal action or causes of legal action, cost and expenses (including attorney fees) caused by Vendor, Vendor's employees, agents or others in the Vendor's party, whether relating to personal injury, death or property damage to (1) any third person(s) or the property of any third person(s) or (2) the Vendor, Vendor's employees or agents or to the property of the Vendor, Vendor's employees or agents.**

**16) Refusal to comply with the Cortez Gun Show Rules and Conditions will result in expulsion of the vendor without refund.**

**Vendor merchandise or services offered for sale, displayed or advertised must be Guns or for Gun Related Activities. (ex. Ammo, parts, scopes, safes, cases, slings). Gunsmith Services, Military Equipment, Knives, Leather Goods (holsters, scabbards, pouches, belts, chaps, saddles etc.) Western Items, Hunting Outfitter Services, Hunting and Shooting Clothing and Headgear and Gun related printed material. Up to 10% of the total tables sold can be reserved for other vendors (approved by management).**
